







Barbara Lynn (Deibert) Greenzweig Specialist 4 U.S. Army 1 June 1978 – 20 October 1980

Barbara was born on 18 December 1956, in Allentown, Pennsylvania, while her family was living at Macungie RD#1. Her parents were Charles Edward Deibert Sr. (born 19 July 1928), who served in the Army in Korea, and Marylyn Gay Zink (born 1 February 1933). Barbara attended grades 1-6 at Longswamp Elementary School in Mertztown, Pennsylvania, and graduated from Brandywine High School in Topton, Pennsylvania, in 1974. She then attended Lock Haven University of Pennsylvania, where she earned a Bachelor's Degree in Psychology in 1978. Barbara enlisted in the Regular Army and was inducted at Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania, on 1 June 1978. She underwent basic training and advanced individual training in Law Enforcement at Ft. McClellan, Alabama, where she qualified with the M-16 rifle, 38 caliber pistol, and grenades, and was classified as a Military Policeman. She was then assigned to Service Company, U.S. Army Intelligence and Security Command (INSCOM) in Augsburg, Germany, where she served for two years with the Military Police. During her tenure in the military, Barbara took graduate-level classes and was awarded her Master of Education Degree in Human Services from Boston University through its overseas program. Barbara was released from active duty in Augsburg and assigned to the Standby Reserve for four months and 18 days to complete the terms of her enlistment on 20 October 1980. After spending an additional six months in Germany, Barbara returned home in 1981 to Macungie. She married Justin Price Greenzweig (born 19 May 1948) on 16 December 1983 in Emmaus, Pennsylvania. They made their home in Palmerton, Pennsylvania. Since 1999, Barbara has been working as a Behavioral Health Rehabilitation Services (BHRS) Case Manager for Carbon Lehigh Intermediate Unit 21 in Palmerton. CLIU21 provides educational and administrative services to schools, and functions as a link between the Pennsylvania Department of Education and local school districts. BHRS services provide in-home support to families with children identified with behavioral and emotional problems. In 2009, Barbara was accepted into the Post Master's Level (on-line) certificate program in Applied Behavior Analysis for a year at Pennsylvania State University. She successfully completed the program and subsequently took board exams and was awarded the title of Board Certified Behavior Analysis (BCBA) certificate in 2011. Barbara and Justin raised four children: Lance Owen, Helena Ruth, Ross Marshall, and Rvan Charles. Justin served in the Army in Vietnam, Ross and Rvan both served in the Army in Iraq, and both are presently serving in the Pennsylvania Army National Guard. In addition to her father and children, Barbara's ancestral family line has a long military tradition of serving in the Armed Forces beginning with her great-great-great-great grandfather, Michael Deibert Sr., in the Pennsylvania Militia during the Revolutionary War, followed by her great-great-great grandfather, Michael Deibert Jr., in the Army during the War of 1812, her great-great grandfather, Solomon Deibert, in the Union Army during the Civil War, and her grandfather, Dr. George Solomon **Deibert**, in the Army during World War I.
