



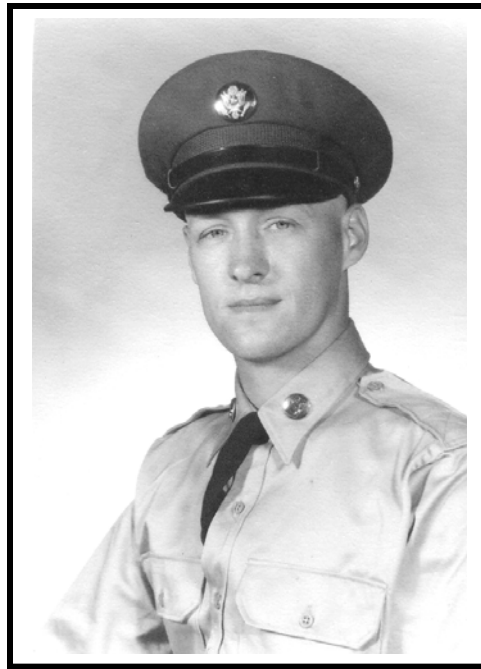

Lloyd Elwood Schueck
Specialist 4 (Technical) U.S. Army
8 July 1963 – 7 July 1965

Lloyd was born on 23 November 1939 in Lower Macungie Township, Pennsylvania, where he was raised. He attended grade school in Lower Macungie: grades 1-4 at Schmoyer's School, a one-room schoolhouse on Spring Creek Road near Kidd Brothers Dairy; grades 5-6 at Brookdale School, also one-room schoolhouse; and grades 7-8 at the new Lower Macungie Elementary School at the intersection of Lower Macungie and South Krocks Roads. He attended 9th Grade at Lincoln Junior High School in Emmaus, Pennsylvania, and graduated from Emmaus High School in 1957. He then went to work for Standard Plastics Company in Fogelsville, Pennsylvania, until 1963. Lloyd was drafted into the Army as a Private in Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania, on 8 July 1963, and was sent to Fort Gordon, Georgia, for basic training. After completing basic training at the end of September 1963, Lloyd was ordered to Fort Hood, Texas, where he was assigned to Headquarters Company, 5th Battalion, 6th Infantry Regiment, 1st Armored Division, 4th Army. He served at Fort Hood as a Ground Surveillance Radar Operator and as an Infantry Operations and Intelligence Specialist for the remainder of his active duty. He was discharged from active duty at Fort Hood as a Specialist 4 (T) on 7 July 1965, and was assigned to the Army Reserves for four years. He returned to Macungie RD#1 where he lived for three years prior to marrying and moving to Wescosville RD#2, Pennsylvania, in 1968. Lloyd married **Lynn Evon Harner** (born on 24 May 1943) in the Lutheran Church in Bel Air, Maryland, on 13 July 1968. They lived in Wescosville until 1971, when they moved to Macungie where they settled. After Lloyd left the Army, he returned to work for Standard Plastics Company in Fogelsville until he married. He then went on to work as a Building Equipment Mechanic for Bell Telephone Company of Pennsylvania, first in Allentown and later in Reading, Pennsylvania, until he retired in December 2001. Lloyd and Lynn have three children: **Mary Ellen**, **Janet Lynn**, and **Nevin Raymond**. Lloyd's parents were **Nevin Willard Schueck** (14 October 1910 – 27 December 1955) and **E. Irene Heistand** (24 August 1910 – 22 July 1987).
